SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF YOUR NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE

Dear Mr. Fil:

In NRC Form 314 dated September 13, 2011, you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate your NRC radioactive materials license. The NRC staff has reviewed your submittal and previous NRC inspection reports. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your facility and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.

Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required and NRC license number 21-19623-01 is hereby terminated.

An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c) (20) (iii).
