Dear Dr. Bondre:

By letter dated September 8, 2011, as supplemented October 28, 2011, Transnuclear, Inc. (TN) submitted an application for an amendment to the Model No. TNF-XI transport package. The application proposes using polyethylene bags during shipment, removes a surface temperature requirement, and updates the package design to meet “-96” requirements. Staff performed an acceptance review of your application to determine if the application contains sufficient technical information in scope and depth to allow the staff to complete the detailed technical review.

This letter acknowledges acceptance of your application. The application appears to contain the information needed for our technical review. We have established a schedule for the review. The schedule allows for staff to issue a Request for Additional Information (RAI) in January 2012 and a CoC/SER in March 2012, based on the applicant responding to RAIs in February 2012. If no RAI is needed, and based on the staff’s evaluation, the approval may be issued at approximately that time. In general, no additional changes to the application should be submitted except for changes resulting from your response to an RAI.
