11/14/2011 (14:05) I left a message on Mr. Baroody's voice-mail for him to get back in touch with me regarding a discrepancy between the manufacturer's information and that provided on August 22, 2011 by Mr. Boggan.  
11/15/2011 (11:25) I left a message for Mr. Boggan to return my call. (14:00) I spoke with Ms. Nicol who stated that both Mssrs. Baroody and Boggan were in the field. She inquired as to the purpose of the phone call. When I stated that it was to clear up a discrepancy between the manufacturer, who had the device as specific, and the Health Department, who believed it was general, I indicated that a visual inspection of the device would clear up the matter. Ms. Nicol brought out the device and stated that the device had three labels and read them to me. None of the labels had the general licensee statement which confirmed that the device was an LPA-1 under specific licensure.  
11/16/2011 (14:05) I left a message with Mr. Baroody to contact me. In the message, I stated that I needed to perform an exit and that the devices could not be used and should be put into storage until the matter of licensure was resolved.
