Note: The results of the expert panel system reviews, completed using the method described in FSAR Subsection 17.4S.1.4, are used to designate, at the system level, the site specific SSCs which have been determined to be risk significant and within the scope of the D-RAP process, and supplement the initial list included in Appendix 19K. In general, the categorization of a system is determined by the highest categorized system function, and the same categorization is given to all components in the system. The expert panel may further refine the system level categorizations at the component level, by categorizing components based on the supported system functions and identifying critical attributes for components determined to be safety/risk significant, using the method described in Subsection 17.4S.1.4.
