

Directions to the Region I office from the following locations:

- Philadelphia Airport
- Interstate 95
- Pennsylvania Turnpike
- Schuylkill Expressway

From the Philadelphia Airport

1. Take 95 south to Route 476 (Blue Route) to Route 76 west to Valley Forge.
2. Continue on Route 76 west to Route 202 north.
3. Once on Route 202 north, make a left turn at the fourth traffic light (Exxon station on left) onto Allendale Road.
4. Stay in the right lane on Allendale.
5. Turn left at the fourth traffic light onto Keebler Road.
6. Follow the access road behind the Medical Center Building to the "L"-shaped building that houses the NRC offices.
7. Enter the lobby at the inside corner of the "L."

From Interstate 95

1. From Interstate 95 take Route 476 (Blue Route) to Route 76 west toward Valley Forge.
2. Continue on Route 76 west to Route 202 north.
3. Once on Route 202 north, make a left turn at the fourth traffic light (Exxon station on left) onto Allendale Road.
4. Stay in the right lane on Allendale.
5. Turn left at the fourth traffic light onto Keebler Road.
6. Follow the access road behind the Medical Center Building to the "L"-shaped building that houses the NRC offices.
7. Enter the lobby at the inside corner of the "L."

From the Pennsylvania Turnpike

1. Follow the Turnpike to the exit for Valley Forge/King of Prussia.
2. Once you exit the Turnpike and pass through the toll area, take the third exit (Route 202 north).
3. Once on Route 202 north, make a left turn at the fourth traffic light (Exxon station on left) onto Allendale Road.
4. Stay in the right lane on Allendale.
5. Turn left at the fourth traffic light onto Keebler Road.
6. Follow the access road behind the Medical Center Building to the "L"-shaped building that houses the NRC offices.
7. Enter the lobby at the inside corner of the "L."

From Schuylkill Expressway (Route 76)

1. Take Route 76 west to Route 202 north.
2. Once on Route 202 north, make a left turn at the fourth traffic light (Exxon station on left) onto Allendale Road.
3. Stay in the right lane on Allendale.
4. Turn left at the fourth traffic light onto Keebler Road.
5. Follow the access road behind the Medical Center Building to the "L"-shaped building that houses the NRC offices.
6. Enter the lobby at the inside corner of the "L."
