Tom Scarbrough has completed his review of your recently submitted RAI responses. His feedback is below. The comments indicate that he plans on issuing follow-up RAIs but you can resubmit your responses if you think that is more efficient.

Tom has suggested that we have a joint phone call between Luminant, MHI and NRC on the IST Program since it is the intent of MHI to fully describe the IST Program. Tom can describe why we still need a COL Item. Tom can also describe the information that needs to be included in the FSAR to address the "implementation" requirement in 10 CFR 52.79(11) since Luminant indicates it will not make design and procurement specifications available for audit.

Dennis,

I have reviewed the Luminant responses to the supplemental RAIs on Comanche Peak FSAR Section 3.9.6. The results of my review are as follows:

RAI 3.9.6-13 (1) Luminant notes that MHI is revising the US-APWR DCD to specify the use of ASME QME-1-2007 as accepted in RG 1.100 (Revision 3). In that the Comanche Peak FSAR incorporates by reference the US-APWR DCD, this portion of the RAI will be resolved when the DCD change is made. (2) Luminant states that design and procurement specifications will not be available for audit prior to Comanche Peak COL issuance. Therefore, we need to discuss with Luminant the information to be included in the FSAR to address the "implementation" requirement in 10 CFR 52.79(11) regarding the IST program to satisfy the ASME OM Code. Supplemental RAI to be prepared.

RAI 3.9.6-14 Luminant states that the US-APWR DCD will fully describe the IST program to be used at Comanche Peak. The COL Information Item for a COL applicant to fully describe the IST program should not be deleted from the US-APWR DCD or the Comanche Peak FSAR because 10 CFR 52.79 and Commission Paper SECY-05-0197 specify that the COL applicant is responsible for describing the IST operational program. In responding to the COL Information Item, the Comanche Peak FSAR may reference the US-APWR DCD with any plant-specific supplemental information. Supplemental RAI to be prepared.

RAI 3.9.6-15 Planned FSAR change to specify use of ASME OM Code, 2004 Edition through 2006 Addenda, is acceptable. Same comment as above regarding COL Information Item.

RAI 3.9.6-16 Planned FSAR change to reference "IST program" instead of "IST program plan" is acceptable. Same comment as above regarding COL Information Item.

RAI 3.9.6-17 Planned FSAR changes are acceptable. Track issue as Confirmatory Item.

RAI 3.9.6-18 Response clarifies FSAR. No FSAR change needed. RAI resolved.

RAI 3.9.6-19 Response clarifies FSAR. No FSAR change needed. RAI resolved.

RAI 3.9.6-20 Proposed use of Regulatory Commitment in lieu of License Condition as specified in RG 1.206 and SECY-05-0197 needs to be addressed by NRC staff. As an editorial comment, the proposed FSAR change should use "Appropriate" rather than "Acceptance" in Note 1 of Table 13.4-201.

We should coordinate the telecons with MHI and Luminant on Section 3.9.6 in the US-APWR DCD and Comanche Peak FSAR.
