To Whom It May Concern:

We are in receipt of your Notice of License Expiration letter, dated November 1, 2011.

LVMH Watch & Jewelry USA, Inc. ("LVMH") has an exempt distribution license (29-23795-02E) that expires on 12/31/2011. It is our intention to renew this license. We understand that your office will not act upon a renewal request for an exempt distribution license until we have our possession license in-place.

LVMH is currently in the process of renewing our possession license (formerly NRC license No. 29-23795-01) with the State of New Jersey: we have filed a possession license renewal application and are waiting to hear back from the Department of Environmental Protection (see letter attached), so this process has yet to be finalized. As such, we respectfully request a six (6) month temporary extension to the expiration date of License No. 29-23795-02E. The requested new expiration date would be 06/30/2012 and we will submit our application for renewal by 05/31/2012 at the latest.

LVMH appreciates your consideration of this request and trusts we will receive an answer in a timely manner so that we may conduct our operations in compliance with all applicable requirements.
