Work activities will consist of removal and packaging of two suspected damaged tritium exit signs, collection of smear samples to assess potential levels of tritium contamination, and pre-emptive decontamination. Based on experience at similar sites, potential removable tritium contamination levels are expected to be 1,000 dpm/100cm² or less. All wastes from the sampling and decontamination activities will be packaged along with the potentially damaged signs for return shipment to the manufacturer.
