Agency Response Dated November 4, 2011:

As part of the Time and Labor (T&L) modernization project, the Office of the Chief Financial Officer (OCFO) has incorporated workflow which allows for electronic workflow and electronic signatures. The OCFO met with the Office of Human Resources to discuss the elimination of various paper leave request forms and also met with the National Treasury Employees Union. As a result of the modernization of the T&L system the Summary Approval Report, all leave request forms, unit transfer forms, and security request forms will be part of the electronic workflow process. The modernization project for the T&L system was deployed October 25, 2011. We consider this recommendation
