Enclosed is your NRC Material License with the new number 21-32838-01. Please note, we have changed the license number because you have relocated your mailing address to the State of Michigan. You will receive a termination for NRC Material License No. 12-00722-06 by separate correspondence.

Please note, as indicated in my phone message, we have not added the Warren, Michigan, address as a location of use at this time because we need clarification and additional information to complete our review as requested in the "Request for Additional Information". Please submit your response as additional information to mail control 576261.

Also note, we have not removed the Rock Island, Illinois, facility as a location of use because your request has been forwarded to your Decommissioning Branch for review. You will be contacted by separate correspondence regarding this matter.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.

NRC's Regulatory Issue Summary (RIS) 2005-31 provides criteria to identify security-related sensitive information and guidance for handling and marking of such documents. This ensures that potentially sensitive information is not made publicly available through ADAMS, the NRC's electronic document system.

The enclosed documents contain sensitive security-related information.
When separated from this cover letter this letter is uncontrolled.
