**At this time I deleted authorization in Condition No. 12.B. for Ibrahim Abdulhay, Ph.D. and Leslie L. Boulay, M.S. as Authorized Medical Physicists (AMPs) for iodine-125 in the Proxima Therapeutics' GliaSite Radiotherapy System as this modality does not require AMPs.**
