Observations/Findings	Licensee did not provide criteria used by the RSO to approve new users and uses of byproduct material. However, regional management believes it is important that license reviewers evaluate the criteria used by broad scope radiation safety committees and RSOs during the renewal process.				
Requirements	<p>The guidance in section 8.7.3 of NUREG-1556, Vol. 11 asks for Type B applicants to submit the criteria used by the RSO to approve of new users and uses of byproduct material. 10 CFR 33.14(b)(2)(ii) states, in part, that an application for a Type B license of broad scope will be approved if the applicant has established administrative procedures that include completion of safety evaluations of proposed uses of byproduct material which take into consideration such matters as the adequacy of facilities and equipment, training and experience of the user, and the operating or handling procedures. There is no specific regulatory requirement to submit these procedures.</p> <p>This was a license renewal that did not meet the criteria for a comprehensive review. Therefore, the reviewer was not required to address in detail every section of NUREG-1556, Vol 11.</p>

Recommendations	<p>a) Request licensee to submit criteria used by their RSO to approving users and uses, and "tie down" the licensee's criteria per license amendment.</p> <p>b) Provide training to DNMS staff on NUREG-1556, Volume 11, Section 8.7.3 for Type B licenses.</p>
