Note that, based on the information provided, we were not able to grant your request that Dr. Sanghi be authorized for all 35.300 materials. To be an authorized user for parenteral administrations requiring a written directive, a physician must meet the requirements of 10 CFR 35.396, including as part of supervised work experience, parenteral administration in at least three cases, as set out in 10 CFR 35.396(d)(2)(vi).
