Please find enclosed Amendment Number 81 to NRC License Number 25-07553-01 **removing an authorized use and a location as requested. In accordance with the radiological criteria for unrestricted use in 10 CFR 20.1402, Yellow Stone Heart Center, 2900 12th Avenue North, Billings, Montana is acceptable for release for unrestricted use. In addition, we acknowledge receipt of the delegation of authority from St. Vincent Healthcare to Christopher Fitz, Radiation Safety Officer.** An environmental assessment for this action is not required since it is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14)(iv).
