On November 14-15, 2011, Tara Weidner and Robin Elliott of this office conducted a safety inspection at the Fort Belvoir Community Hospital, Fort Belvoir, Virginia of activities authorized by the above listed NRC license. The inspection was an examination of your licensed activities as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's regulations and the license conditions. The inspection consisted of observations by the inspector, interviews with personnel, and a selective examination of representative records. The results of the inspection were discussed at a debriefing on November 15, 2011 with CAPT Robert Buckley, Chief of Staff, LTC Kenneth Shaw, Assistant Deputy Commander, Clinical Support Services and other members of your staff. A telephonic exit meeting was held on December 6, 2011 with LTC Francis Fota.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations were identified.
