The purpose of this letter is to notify you of our intention to initiate activities at a temporary jobsite under this license.

The work will be conducted at the military base located in Al Kharj in Saudi Arabia.

Tetra Tech EC, Inc. (TtEC) has been contracted by the U.S. Army Engineering and Support Center, Huntsville to collect depleted uranium (DU) munitions and fragments mixed within barrels and storage vaults for return to the United States for disposal at the Hanford disposal site. An estimate of 1000 pounds of DU is anticipated to be transported to the United States. However, the final quantity will not be determined until radiological surveys have been completed.

The expected start date is December 28, 2011, with a completion date of January 17, 2012. Dates of the project may shift based on the time to survey equipment, and to prepare for shipment.
