On December 19, 2011, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) received the Union Electric Company application dated December 19, 2011, for renewal of the operating license for Callaway Plant, Unit 1. We are currently performing an acceptance review for docketing in accordance with the requirements of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* Section 2.101 (10 CFR 2.101) and will notify you of the results of our review. Should the NRC staff determine that the application is acceptable for docketing, a schedule for the review will then be provided to you.

Mr. Brian K. Harris will be the project manager for the safety review, and Ms. Carmen Fells will be the project manager for the environmental review of your license renewal application. Mr. Mohan Thadani continues to remain responsible for the project management of all issues other than license renewal for Callaway Plant, Unit 1.

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC or Commission) has received an application, dated December 19, 2011, from Union Electric Company, filed pursuant to Section 103 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and in Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* Part 54 (10 CFR Part 54), to renew the operating license for Callaway Plant, Unit 1 (Callaway). Callaway is a pressurized water reactor designed by Westinghouse. Renewal of the license would authorize the applicant to operate the facility for an additional 20-year period beyond the period specified in the current operating license. The current operating license for Callaway (NPF-30) expires on October 18, 2024. The acceptability of the tendered application for docketing, and other matters including an opportunity to request a hearing, will be the subject of subsequent *Federal Register* notices.
