SUMMARY

This refers to application, NRC Form 313, dated May 15, 2011 and the phone conversation between Stan Essner and Mike Herr on **November 3, 2011**.

During our review of your application date May 15, 2011, it appeared that your application had not been completely prepared in accordance with the guidance in NUREG 1556, Vol. 4, dated October 1998, "Consolidated Guidance about Materials Licenses: Program-Specific Guidance about Fixed Gauge Licenses." This omission has resulted in an incomplete application and we will need you to resubmit your application for renewal in entirety now.

The NUREG previously mentioned needs to be reviewed to ensure you understand the commitments that you will be making in your responses, as discussed below, to Appendix B of this NUREG. Using Appendix B is the simplest way to prepare your renewal and helps to ensure a more complete application.

You should already have a hard copy of this NUREG but we are advising you of the website availability of this NUREG also.

Appendix B can be used to capture the information required in Items 5-11 of NRC Form 313, focusing on the responses and commitments in Appendix B.

Please note that certain NRC policies have been modified since its last revision, as noted below:

Please provide the manufacture names and model numbers for the devices that you posses. These names and model numbers need match the Sealed Source and Device Registry certificate procured by the vendor. Please provide the names and model numbers for the devices you posses.

Note that our standard terminology for your request of an Assistant Radiation Safety Officer is "Alternate" Radiation Safety Officer (ARSO). A license can only have one RSO at a time. Please provide a signed and written statement that the ARSO will only act as the RSO in the physical absence of the RSO.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS), accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>.

Upon receipt of your response we will resume our review, Address your written response to my attention at the above address and please be sure to reference Control No. 575169 to facilitate proper handling in our office. As a reminder, please provide the information requested in writing, accompanied by a transmittal letter appropriately dated and signed by a senior management official.

Please submit the requested information within 3 calendar days (by **November 10, 2011**) by referencing control number **575169** to facilitate proper handling. Upon receipt of your response we will resume our review. Address your written response to my attention at the above address.


