Subject: Request for additional information to remove/add authorized users

Michelle Aines, the Director of Radiology for Porter Medical Center, Inc. (PMCI), sent in an amendment request to remove two authorized users (AUs) and attached a list of doctors that should be on the license. I explained to Ms. Aines that the amendment request should be signed by a member of senior management. There were also two additional AUs on the license that were not on the list (Dr. J. Lorimer Holm and Dr. Joseph Winget). I asked if these physicians should be removed as well and she said she would need to find out. There were five additional physicians on the list that were not on the license (Dr. Daniel Raabe, Dr. Steffen Hillemann, Dr. Janet Kirwan, Dr. Bartholomew Bonazinga, and Dr. Christopher Higgins). Doing an ADAMS search, I found that Drs. Hillemann, Kirwan, and Higgins have been on NRC licenses in the past year and could be added by referencing the other NRC licenses they were on (Hillemann and Kirwan were on NRC License Number 37-28520-01; Hillemann, Kirwan, and Higgins were on NRC License Number 44-30682-01). I explained that Drs. Raabe and Bonazinga would need to fill out the NRC Form 313A (AUD) and I explained the NRC requirements for adding them as AUs. She wasn't sure if Drs. Raabe and Bonazinga would need to be added because they only do the occasional reading of studies. I told Ms. Aines that PMCI should send in a new letter signed by senior management, list all authorized users to be removed, and list all authorized users to be added. She indicated that she would do this.
