Barker's Junk Company was contacted to request information regarding scrap metal removed from the Deepgreen West Virginia coal processing facility near Pageton, WV, in 2010. The facility was renovated and scrap metal was discarded and removed by Barker's to be recycled. Cody Darby, the Barker Manager, said the material removed was scanned by their radiation monitors and no radioactive material was identified. He also informed me that the steel mills that Barker sells scrap metal to employ radiation monitors on all incoming shipments of metal and that no shipments had been rejected based on radiation readings. Barkers did not identify the missing density gauge while processing the scrap metal from the Pageton site.
