1E GAS TURBINE GENERATOR SYSTEM (MUAP-10023) REVISION 3, MHI

Dear Mr. Ogata:

By letter to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) dated September 21, 2011 (UAP-HF-11318), you submitted an affidavit requesting that the information contained in the following document be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR), Part 2, Section 2.390:

Submission of Technical Report, Initial Type Test Result of Class 1E Gas Turbine Generator (MUAP-10023), Revision 3

Nonproprietary copies of these documents have been placed in the NRC's Public Document Room and added to the Agency Wide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Public Electronic Reading Room under accession number ML11271A052.

The affidavit stated that the submitted information should be considered exempt from mandatory public disclosure for the following reasons:

- The basis for holding the referenced information confidential is that it describes the unique design of the gas turbine generator system, developed by MHI, KHI, and ESI and not used in the exact form by any of MHI's, KHI's, and ESI's competitors. This information was developed at significant cost to MHI, KHI, and ESI, since it required the performance of Research and Development, detailed design for its software and hardware extending over several years.
- Public disclosure of the referenced information would assist competitors of MHI in their design of new nuclear power plants without incurring the costs or risks associated with the design of the subject systems. Therefore, disclosure of the information contained in the referenced technical report would have the following negative impacts on the competitive position of MHI in the U.S. nuclear plant market.
 - A. Loss of competitive advantage due to the costs associated with development of the class 1E gas turbine generator. Providing public access to such information permits competitors to duplicate or mimic the technology without incurring the associated costs.

- B. Loss of competitive advantage of the US-APWR created by benefits of enhanced plant safety, and reduced operation and maintenance costs associated with the class 1E gas turbine generator.

We have reviewed your application and the material in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.390 and, on the basis of the statements in the affidavit, have determined that the submitted information sought to be withheld contains proprietary commercial information and should be withheld from public disclosure. Therefore, the submitted information marked as proprietary will be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.390(b)(5) and Section 103(b) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended.

Withholding from public inspection shall not affect the right, if any, of persons properly and directly concerned to inspect the documents. If the need arises, we may send copies of this information to our consultants working in this area. We will, of course, ensure that the consultants have signed the appropriate agreements for handling proprietary information.

If the basis for withholding this information from public inspection should change in the future such that the information could then be made available for public inspection, you should promptly notify the NRC. You also should understand that the NRC may have cause to review this determination in the future, for example, if the scope of a Freedom of Information Act request includes your information. In all review situations, if the NRC makes a determination adverse to the above, you will be notified in advance of any public disclosure.
