Dear Mr. Dietrich:

This refers to an investigation conducted by the NRC's Office of Investigations regarding activities at San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station. The Office of Investigations initiated the investigation to determine whether two mechanics at Southern California Edison Company's San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station, San Clemente, California, willfully falsified a work order during maintenance activities.

Based on the evidence developed during the investigation, testimony, and document reviews, the allegation was not determined to be willful. The NRC plans no further action related to the willful aspect of this allegation and considers this investigation closed.
