Please note that we changed the single source activity limit for sources listed in Items 8. A & B and the model name in Item 9. A & B in your NRC License to match the information provided in the Sealed Source Device Registry for the Troxler Electronic Laboratories Model 3400 Series.

We also corrected the address in License Condition No. 10. The address was incorrectly listed as 944 N. Griffith Boulevard in Amendment No. 02 of your NRC license instead of 1944 N. Griffith Boulevard. We apologize for any inconvenience that this may have caused.

Please also note that we removed License Condition Nos. 11. B as it appeared in Amendment No. 02 of your NRC Materials License. You will no longer be able to self-appoint Radiation Safety Officers (RSO) as these conditions previously allowed, the NRC must do that for you as part of the amendment process.

For future RSO changes please submit the name of the proposed RSO; his/her training and experience qualifications; a statement signed and dated by the proposed RSO that s/he accepts the position as RSO and that s/he understands the duties and responsibilities associated with the RSO position.
