Dear COL Canfield:

This refers to your license amendment request. Enclosed with this letter is the amended license adding COL Thomas D. Bresley, M.D. and Dr. Michael T. Oberhofer, M.D. as authorized users (AUs). As discussed with CPT Gary L. Hall, your Radiation Safety Officer, the 35.300 authorizations for these AUs have been limited to oral administration of sodium iodide iodine-131. In order to authorize parenteral administration of any beta emitter or photon-emitting radionuclide with a photon energy less than 150 keV, please submit documentation to demonstrate that COL Bresley and Dr. Oberhofer each meet the requirements of 10 CFR 35.390(a)(1) or (b)(1), and (b)(1)(ii)(G)(3), including the preceptor attestation required by 35.390(b)(2).

This amendment also removes Dr. Kyle R. Walker, M.D. as AU. LTC Ida. M. Santiago-Maldonado, M.D. was not removed because CPT Hall informed us that she is still working at your facility.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand and fully implement all the conditions incorporated into the amended license. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region I Office, Licensing Assistance Team, (610) 337-5239, so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14).
