Dear Mr. Haengel:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 03 renewing your NRC Material License No. 21-32321-01 in accordance with your request.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

Please note that we removed License Condition Nos. 11. B as it appeared in Amendment No. 02 of your NRC Materials License. You will no longer be able to self-appoint Radiation Safety Officers (RSO) as these conditions previously allowed, the NRC must do that for you as part of the amendment process.

For future RSO changes please submit the name of the proposed RSO; his/her training and experience qualifications; a statement signed and dated by the proposed RSO that s/he accepts the position as RSO and that s/he understands the duties and responsibilities associated with the RSO position.

We also updated your NRC Materials License by adding License Condition No. 13. F and modifying License Condition No. 19 as they appeared in Amendment No. 02 of your NRC License. These changes should enhance your awareness of regulatory requirements and the radiation safety program elements in your license.

Lastly, we removed License Condition No. 19 and 21 as it appeared in Amendment No. 02 of your license. License Condition No. 19 is no longer needed since you now have possession limits in your license and License Condition No. 21 is not needed because the gauges you possess do not have the capability to go below the surface of the ground greater than three feet.



You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions.

Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
