**Dear Frank,**

The following are answers from Covanta Indianapolis, Inc. to the five (5) questions contained in the e-mail message that you sent to Thomas A. Wehrenberg (Covanta Environmental Compliance Specialist) on November 18, 2011.

**Answer to Question No. 1**

We confirm that the maximum activity of Cs-137 in each installed gauge will be 100 millicuries and the maximum total activity of Cs-137 will be 1 curie.

**Answer to Question No. 2**

We confirm that operating and emergency procedures will be developed, implemented, maintained, and distributed, and will meet the Criteria in the section entitled "Radiation Safety Program – Operating and Emergency Procedures," in NUREG – 1556, Vol. 4, dated October 1998.

**Answer to Question No. 3**

We confirm that the sealed sources will be used as listed on the Sealed Source and Device Registration Certificate.

**Answer to Question No. 4**

We confirm that radiation surveys pursuant to the 10 CFR 20.1501 will be performed by a person specifically authorized by the NRC or an agreement State to perform these surveys.

**Answer to Question No. 5**

We will not use these gauges at temporary jobsites.

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

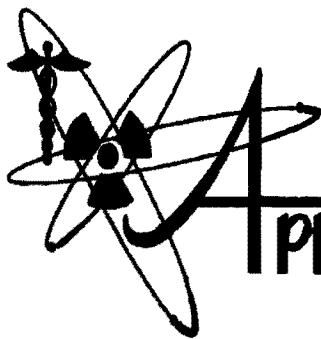
