**International Energy Agency Seen To Be Increasingly In Favor Of Alternative Energy.** The website for the [Discovery Channel](#) (12/1, Mulvaney) reports that "in the past," the International Energy Agency "has taken some criticism for allegedly underestimating the viability of, and need for, alternative energies in favor of more traditional power generation such as coal or nuclear." But recently, that has changed. The article notes that "earlier this year, the agency projected that solar energy could produce most of the world's power by 2060" and "at the beginning of November, it added that the development of renewables was being held back by over \$400 billion of 'wasteful' fossil fuel subsidies and that ending such subsidies was the most important policy step toward limiting the impacts of global warming." Also, "the IEA concluded in a new book released last week, the necessary alternative technologies are not only available, they are increasingly viable and are, in many cases, flourishing."
