This refers to: (1) your August 29, 2011 request to expand the radioactive materials use authorizations for Tae Chung, M.D., and (2) to our telephone conversation on November 21, 2011, in which we indicated that additional information would be needed from you. In a letter dated December 5, 2011, you withdrew your request to modify Dr. Chung's Radioactive Materials use authorizations.

In accordance with your correspondence, we have voided your August 29, 2011, license amendment request. This action is without prejudice to resubmission. If you resubmit your request, please state that the resubmission is additional information to Control Number 576756.

In addition, due to a change in NRC's licensing policies, we have issued a Corrected Copy of Amendment No. 71 to your NRC Material License No. 13-01787-01. As discussed by phone on December 9, 2011, we have reinserted two Authorized Users, inadvertently omitted in Amendment No. 71. In addition, please also note we have added a total possession limit for Item 8.C. of your license. If this is insufficient to meet your needs, or if you have any questions or require clarification on any of the information stated in this letter, please contact the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office immediately at (630) 829-9887.


