NRC TO MEET WITH ENERGY NORTHWEST OFFICIALS TO DISCUSS PERFORMANCE IMPROVEMENTS AT COLUMBIA NUCLEAR POWER PLANT

U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff will meet with officials from Energy Northwest on Jan. 9 to discuss initiatives being implemented to improve performance of the Columbia Generating Station. The nuclear plant is located near Richland, Wash.

The meeting, which is open to public observation, will begin at 1:30 p.m. in the NRC Region IV office at 1600 E. Lamar Blvd., in Arlington, Texas.

Conferees will discuss the status of performance improvement initiatives at the plant.
