We reviewed your letter dated October 13, 2011 and your response letter dated December 1, 2011. Based on your provided information, we have authorized the release of your location of use at 22972 Lahser Road, Southfield, Michigan, for unrestricted use.

In addition, we have revised your license conditions 9.A and 9.B to reflect our current policy.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any questions or errors, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate answers and corrections.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
