We have reviewed your letter, dated November 14, 2011, transmitting changes to the Fundamental Nuclear Material Control Plan for low-enriched uranium. We find the changes to be acceptable. Specifically, we find that Nuclear Fuel Services was authorized to make the changes without prior U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) approval pursuant to the requirements in Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR), Section 70.32. The license condition for this plan will be updated in a future amendment to reflect the changes.

Upon issuance of this letter, TAC L33196 will be closed.
