NRC ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON THE MEDICAL USES OF ISOTOPES SELECTS NEW MEMBER; WILL HOLD TELECONFERENCE MEETING FEB. 7

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission has selected Darice Bailey as the State Government Representative on the Advisory Committee on the Medical Uses of Isotopes (ACMUI). The ACMUI was established in 1958, and advises the NRC on policy and technical issues related to the regulation of the medical uses of radioactive material.

Bailey is a health physicist currently serving as the manager of the Radioactive Materials Group at the Texas Department of State Health Services, Radiation Control Program in Austin, Texas. There she is responsible for the oversight of inspection and enforcement for more than 2,000 licensees. She also serves as a member of the state's radiological emergency response team.

Bailey is active in various professional organizations and serves in leadership roles for both the Conference of Radiation Control Program Directors and the Organization of Agreement States. She has also participated in NRC committee activities for the Ritenour Petition and the Medical Event Rulemaking committee.

Bailey holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Community Health with a minor in Biology from East Tennessee State University, in Johnson City, Tenn. She has more than 27 years experience in radiation regulation and has long tenure working as a health physicist in California, Tennessee and Texas.

In other business, the ACMUI will convene a teleconference meeting on Feb. 7, 2012, to discuss the Permanent Implant Brachytherapy Subcommittee Report.
