Mr. Jensen:

We had a long discussion on December 12, which I followed up in an email that same day, and letter dated December 13, 2012. During the conversation, you indicated that you would be closing the possession and distribution location at SLI/Midwest, 221 S. Franklin Road #C, Indianapolis, Indiana. During the telephone conversation, you stated that you expected this closure to be completed by the end of December. We can terminate the NRC possession license when all licensed materials are removed from the Indianapolis location. Please send a signed, hard-copy letter, letting us know if all materials are removed so that the license termination can be completed.

If this closure is delayed and not expected to be completed by the end of January, please let me know. If that is the case, we will void this licensing action, without

prejudice, and open a new
action when you submit a letter telling us that the closure is complete.
