Doane, Director /RA/ Office of International Programs</p> <p>Date: February 3, 2012</p> <p>Subject: GOVERNMENT OF JAPAN REQUESTS THAT IAEA OPEN FUKUSHIMA SATELLITE OFFICE</p> <p>Comment: On January 28, 2012, the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) Director General Yukiya Amano announced that he is "carefully considering" a request from the Government of Japan to open a satellite IAEA office in Fukushima Prefecture. Speaking to reporters during the World Economic Forum in Davos, Switzerland, Amano noted that such an office would enable the IAEA to have "close contact" on Japan's progress in mitigating the effects of the Fukushima accident.</p> <p>According to an <i>Agence France Presse</i> report on the subject, "Tokyo wants an international seal of approval for the energy-hungry country's nuclear industry to bolster its faltering efforts at reassuring the public it is safe to resume atomic operations."
