Dear Mr. Pacher:

On December 21, 2011, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) completed a security baseline inspection at your R.E. Ginna Nuclear Power Plant. The inspection report documents one of the key attributes of the security cornerstone of the NRC's Reactor Oversight Process. The enclosed inspection report documents the inspection results, which were discussed on December 21, 2011, with you and other members of your staff.

The inspection examined activities conducted under your license as they relate to security and compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspector reviewed selected procedures and records, observed activities, and interviewed personnel.

This report documents one NRC-identified finding of very low security significance (i.e., Green as determined by the Baseline Security Significance Determination Process). The finding had a cross-cutting aspect in the area of Human Performance (Resources) because Ginna did not have complete, accurate and up-to-date procedures [H.2(c)]. The inspector determined that this finding also involved a violation of NRC requirements. However, because of the very low security significance and because it was entered into your corrective action program, the NRC is treating this violation as a non-cited violation (NCV) consistent with section 2.3.2 of the NRC Enforcement Policy. If you contest this NCV, you should provide a response within 30 days of the date of this inspection report, with the basis for your denial, to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, ATTN.: Document Control Desk, Washington DC 20555-0001; with copies to the Regional Administrator Region I; the Director, Office of Enforcement, United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, DC 20555-0001; and the NRC resident inspectors at R.E. Ginna Nuclear Power Plant. In addition, if you disagree with the cross-cutting aspect assigned to the finding in this report, you should provide a response within 30 days of the date of this inspection report, with the basis for your disagreement, to the Regional Administrator, Region I, and the NRC resident inspectors at R.E. Ginna Nuclear Power Plant.

Enclosure contains Sensitive Unclassified Non-Safeguards Information. When separated from the Enclosure, this document is decontrolled.
