By letter dated January 6, 2012, Lost Creek ISR, LLC (LCI) submitted to U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff a request to amend its license to allow operation of two vacuum dryers as an option within the Central Processing Plant (CPP). This letter acknowledges receipt of the exemption request and notifies LCI that NRC staff has started the acceptance review. NRC staff expects to complete this review by March 23, 2012, at which time the staff will inform LCI of its determination of acceptability.
