I reviewed MIMG's amendment request to add Richard L. Smith, II, M.D. as an authorized user for 35.100 and 35.200. His NRC Form 313A (AUD) indicated that he did not have any generator experience. I spoke with Ms. Brenda Houser and explained that Dr. Smith would need some documentation to show experience with eluting generator systems appropriate for the preparation of radioactive drugs for imaging and localization studies, measuring and testing the eluate for radionuclidic purity, and processing the eluate with reagent kits to prepare labeled radioactive drugs. I explained that many licensees meet this requirement by getting hands-on training at a radiopharmacy and having the training documented by a radiopharmacist. I asked that Ms. Houser submit the requested information by February 24, 2012.
