PUERTO RICO, AND NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Rhoe:

On January 4-5, 2012, Kathy Modes of this office conducted a safety inspection at the above address and accompanied you to the Doctors' Center Hospital, and the Hospital Hermanos Melendez, Inc., in Bayamon, Puerto Rico. The inspection was an examination of your licensed activities as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's regulations and the license conditions. The inspection consisted of observations by the inspector, interviews with personnel, and an examination of records. Additional information provided in your correspondence dated January 11 and 17, 2012 was also examined as part of the inspection. The findings of the inspection were discussed with you at the conclusion of the inspection on February 3, 2012, by a telephonic exit meeting.

Based on the results of this inspection and in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy, the NRC has identified one violation of NRC requirements. The violation involved CRMI not verifying before they transferred byproduct material that the recipient was authorized to receive the material being transferred, as required by 10 CFR 30.41(c). A Notice of Violation (Notice) is enclosed that categorizes this violation as a Severity Level IV. This violation is being cited in the Notice, because the violation was identified by the NRC.

You are required to respond to this letter in regards to the violation and should follow the instructions specified in the enclosed Notice when preparing your response. For your consideration, review the NRC Information Notice 96-28, "Suggested Guidance Relating to Development and Implementation of Corrective Action," at the NRC website at www.nrc.gov; select **NRC Library; Document Collections; Generic Communication**; then **Information Notices**. The NRC will use your response, in part, to determine whether further enforcement action is necessary to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter, its enclosure, and your response, will be made available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the NRC document system (ADAMS), accessible from the NRC website at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>. To the extent possible, your response should not include any personal privacy, proprietary, or safeguards information so that it can be made available to the Public without redaction.
