SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE NO. 25-29355-01

Dear Mr. Gebhardt:

By letter dated November 21, 2011, Ash Grove Cement Company informed the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) that you wished to terminate your NRC radioactive materials license. The NRC Form 314 dated November 21, 2011, stated that all radioactive material had been transferred to an authorized licensee.

The supporting documentation to the NRC Form 314 also provided a copy of the most recent leak test of the portable gauge showing no leakage and a letter from the licensee acknowledging receipt of the portable gauge. The NRC staff has reviewed the supporting documentation to your NRC Form 314. Based on the documentation submitted and a review of your historical file, the staff concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from the facility and the facility at 100 Highway 518, Clancy, Montana 59634 is suitable for unrestricted use in accordance with 10 CFR 20.1402, "Radiological Criteria for Unrestricted Use." Based on these conclusions, no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required.

Please find enclosed Amendment Number 02 to License Number 25-29355-01, authorizing your license termination. An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(20)(iii).
