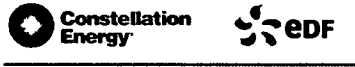

Addressees are required to provide a written response to the NRC in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(f).

In Bulletin 2011-01, the NRC requested each licensee to submit a written response within 30 days and 60 days of the date of the Bulletin. The 60-day response was provided in Reference (a). Reference (b) requested additional information concerning our 60-day response.




