Notice of Meeting

The ACRS Subcommittee on U.S. Advanced Pressurized Power Reactor (US-APWR) will hold a meeting on March 22-23, 2012, Room T-2B1, 11545 Rockville Pike, Rockville, Maryland.

The entire meeting will be open to public attendance, with the exception of a portion that may be closed to protect information that is proprietary pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552b(c)(4).

The agenda for the subject meeting shall be as follows:

Thursday, March 22, 2012 – 8:30 AM until 5:00 PM; Friday, March 23, 2012 – 8:30 AM until 5:00 PM

The Subcommittee will review Chapter 9, “Auxiliary Systems” of the Safety Evaluation Report (SER) with open items associated with the US-APWR design certification. The Subcommittee will hear presentations by and hold discussions with the NRC staff, Mitsubishi Heavy Industries (MHI), and other interested persons regarding this matter. The Subcommittee will gather information, analyze relevant issues and facts, and formulate proposed positions and actions, as appropriate, for deliberation by the Full Committee.

Members of the public desiring to provide oral statements and/or written comments should notify the Designated Federal Official (DFO), Mrs. Ilka Berrios (Telephone 301-415-3179 or Email: [Ilka.Berrios@nrc.gov](mailto:Ilka.Berrios@nrc.gov)) five days prior to the meeting, if possible, so that appropriate

arrangements can be made. Thirty-five hard copies of each presentation or handout should be provided to the DFO thirty minutes before the meeting. In addition, one electronic copy of each presentation should be emailed to the DFO one day before the meeting. If an electronic copy cannot be provided within this timeframe, presenters should provide the DFO with a CD containing each presentation at least thirty minutes before the meeting. Electronic recordings will be permitted only during those portions of the meeting that are open to the public. Detailed procedures for the conduct of and participation in ACRS meetings were published in the *Federal Register* on October 17, 2011, (76 FR 64127-64128).
