Damage to the main transformers and the reserve transformers (bushings that were replaced to allow restoration of offsite power). No other reported damage; however, walkdowns of the plant equipment inside the reactor buildings are ongoing. There is ongoing analysis by NRC and licensee on the actual earthquake levels experienced versus the design basis.
