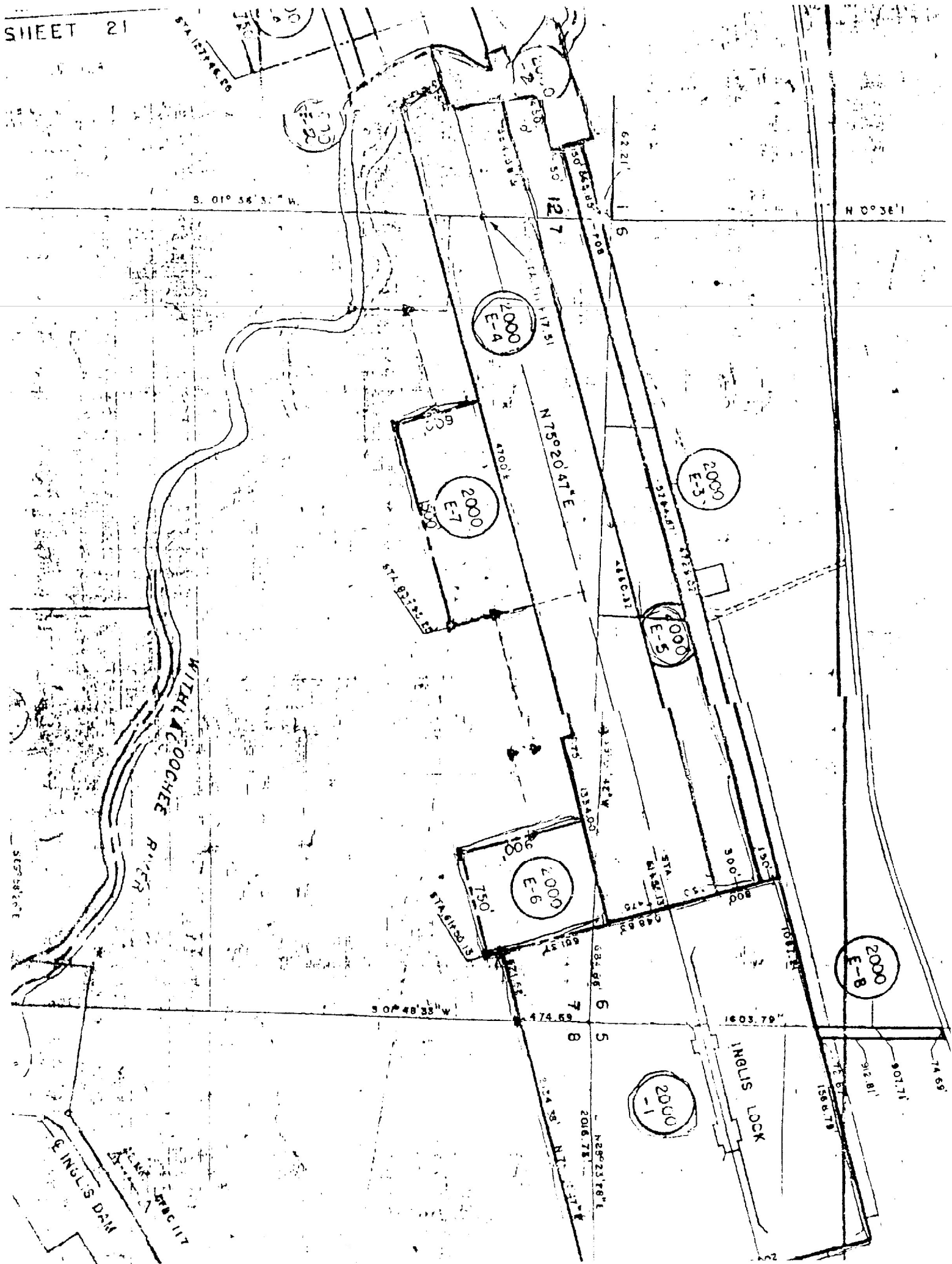

Stumbo, Acting Secretary of the Army, under and pursuant to Section 402 of the Water Resources Development Act of 1990, Public Law 101-640, party of the first part, and THE STATE OF FLORIDA ACTING BY AND THROUGH THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INTERNAL IMPROVEMENT TRUST FUND OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA, with its principal place of business in Tallahassee, Florida, party of the second part;

WITNESSETH:

THAT WHEREAS, the Cross Florida Barge Canal Project, authorized in 1942 by Public Law 77-675, consisted of a high-level lock barge canal, approximately 107 miles long stretching from the St. Johns River at Palatka, Florida to the Gulf of Mexico near Inglis, Florida; and

WHEREAS, Section 1114 of the Water Resources Development Act of 1986, Public Law 99-662 established the Cross Florida National Conservation Area; and

WHEREAS, Section 402 of the Water Resources Development Act of 1990, Public Law 101-640, provides for deauthorization of the Cross Florida Barge Canal Project by operation of law immediately upon the Governor and Cabinet of the State of Florida adopting a resolution specifically agreeing to the terms prescribed in subsection (b) of Section 1114 of the Water Resources Development Act of 1986 (Public Law 99-662), as amended by subsection (b) of Section 402 of the Water Resources Development Act of 1990 (Public Law 101-640); and

WHEREAS, Section 402 of the Water Resources Development Act of 1990 (Public Law 101-640) directs the Secretary of the Army to transfer to the State of Florida all lands and interests in lands acquired by the Secretary and facilities completed for the project without consideration if the State of Florida adopts the required resolution; and

WHEREAS, on January 22, 1991, the Governor and Cabinet of the State of Florida, composed of the Secretary of State, the Attorney General, the Comptroller, the State Treasurer, the Commissioner of Agriculture, and the Commissioner of Education, adopted and executed a resolution (attached hereto as Exhibit "A") specifically agreeing on behalf of the State of Florida to the terms and conditions of subsection (b) of Section 1114 of the Water Resources Development Act of 1986 (Public Law 99-662), as amended by subsection (b) of Section 402 of the Water Resources Development Act of 1990 (Public Law 101-640); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 253.002 and 253.02 of the Florida Statutes, the title to lands, acquired by, transferred to, managed by, or disposed of by the State of Florida, are to be held by or transferred to the Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund of the State of Florida, composed of the Governor and the following State Cabinet Members: the Secretary of State, the Attorney General, the Comptroller, the State Treasurer, the Commissioner of Education, and the Commissioner of Agriculture.
