On March 3, 10, 17, 24, and 31, 2011, Category 1 public meetings / teleconferences were held between the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and representatives of the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) at NRC Headquarters, One White Flint North, 11555 Rockville Pike, Rockville, Maryland. The purpose of the meetings was to discuss the NRC staff's questions and comments on the Watts Bar Nuclear Plant Unit 2 Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR), Section 7 Instrumentation and Control, in support of TVA's application for an operating license.

The meetings consisted of the NRC staff and TVA staff discussing the outstanding open items for the review of Section 7 to the FSAR.
