SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF WEEKLY CONFERENCE CALL MEETING TO DISCUSS
OPEN ITEMS AND OUTSTANDING REQUESTS FOR ADDITIONAL
INFORMATION RESPONSES RELATING TO NUCLEAR INNOVATION
NORTH AMERICA'S SOUTH TEXAS PROJECT UNITS 3 AND 4
COMBINED LICENSE APPLICATION ON FEBRAURY 22, 2012

On Wednesday, February 22, 2012, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's staff held a public conference call from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. with members of Nuclear Innovation North America's (NINA). The purpose of the conference call was to discuss the status of the remaining open items (OI) related to the NINA Combined License Application (COLA). In addition, several requests for additional information were discussed in further detail.

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Discussion Topic	Discussion Outcome
1. Chapter 9 Topics	Discussion concerning schedule and coordination of NINA responses expected next week.
2. Open Item Master List	Open item master list was discussed to update the current status. Review of Revision 7 of the FSAR to close CI is ongoing.
3. Chapter 3 Topics	<p>There is an internal meeting during the week of February 27 to discuss the RWB classification analysis. Because of schedule conflict, the next meeting with NINA on this topic is March 7, 2012.</p> <p>Discussed Chapter 3.9.2 and the computer code ABACUS, and the open issue on ACSTIC2 V&V. A public meeting is tentatively planned on March 21.</p> <p>Staff requested the NINA process of developing specification should be captured in the FSAR to be consistent with SRP guidance that the applicant has a methodology to determine loads in a Class 1 component.</p> <p>The February 27, 2012 audit of Chapters 3.7 and 3.8 and response to RG 1.221 RAI is confirmed and an audit plan has been issued this week.</p>
