The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers as a cooperating agency have completed the final environmental impact statement (EIS) for combined licenses for Levy Nuclear Plant Units 1 and 2. A copy of the final EIS, NUREG-1941, "Environmental Impact Statement for the Combined Licenses (COLs) for Levy Nuclear Plant Units 1 and 2: Final Report," is included with this letter for your information. Comments received from consulting parties and members of the public on the draft EIS were considered and responses are provided in Appendix E of the final EIS.

A notice of availability of the final EIS is anticipated to be published by the NRC on May 4, 2012 in the *Federal Register*. The EIS is available for public inspection at the NRC Public Document Room, located at One White Flint North, 11555 Rockville Pike, Rockville, Maryland 20852, or from the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access Management System (ADAMS) under the accession numbers ML12100A063, ML12100A068, and ML12100A070.
