As we recently discussed, Earl DiGioia, the Radiation Safety Officer at Light Sources Inc., has recently reduced his hours to part time status. He will continue to work at Light Sources Inc. for the next six months or more. Please accept this letter as notification that we need to amend our NRC License to name a new Radiation Safety Officer.


Our new Radiation Safety Officer will be Mr. Robert Miske, Jr. Mr. Miske has been with Light Sources Inc. for fifteen years. He has been a senior member of our Safety Committee, and is currently President of the Safety Committee. He has completed DOT, RCRA, and Hazwoper training, and has worked closely with Mr. DiGioia at Light Sources, Inc. In addition, on 2/21/2012, Mr. Miske completed Radiation Safety Officer training as provided by our consultant, a certified health physicist. The topics covered during the live training session included:

Radiation Protection Principles, Characteristics of Ionizing Radiation, Units of Radiation Dose and Quantities, Radiation Detection Instrumentation, Biological Hazards of Exposure to Radiation appropriate to the krypton-85 requested in our license, NRC and State Regulatory Requirements and Standards, Identification and Control of potential radiation hazards, and Conducting Surveys.

Please note that Light Sources Inc. has also notified US NRC Headquarters [Bruce Carrico] of the change of RSO in conjunction with our pending distribution license.
