Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

Please note, as we discussed by telephone on February 16, 2012, we have not included the Radiation Safety Manual dated November 2011, because it appears that the facilities may be different than the facilities that were approved in your application dated June 24, 2011. Please review your Radiation Safety Manual and resubmit it as additional information to **mail control 576449**. You may also wish to review the license application information in NUREG-1556, Volume 7, which can be found on your website at http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/nuregs/staff/sr1556/v7/index.html.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
