In the February 14, 2012, letter, transmitting the approved Amendment No. 2 to the Certificate of Compliance No. 1031 for the NAC International, Inc. MAGNASTOR® System (ML120320241), we indicated that you were required to submit an original final safety analysis report (FSAR) to the Commission, in accordance with 10 CFR 72.4, within 90 days after the spent fuel storage cask design had been approved. In fact, updated FSARs are required only for new certificates, or every two years. While we would appreciate a courtesy copy of the updated FSAR, to assist us in reviewing current and future amendment requests, and to enable efficient and effective inspections of the Amendment No. 2 designs, you are not required to submit an updated FSAR at this time.
