SUBJECT: CLOSURE OF INVESTIGATION (OI 4-2011-032)

Dear Mr. Bannister:

This refers to an investigation conducted by the NRC's Office of Investigations regarding activities at Fort Calhoun Station. The Office of Investigations initiated the investigation to determine whether an instrumentation and control coordinator at Omaha Public Power District's Fort Calhoun Station was subjected to discrimination for reporting nuclear safety concerns related to a reactor coolant system modification.

Based on the evidence developed during the investigation, testimony, and document reviews, the alleged discrimination was determined to be not substantiated. The NRC plans no further action related to the discrimination aspect of this allegation and considers this investigation closed.
